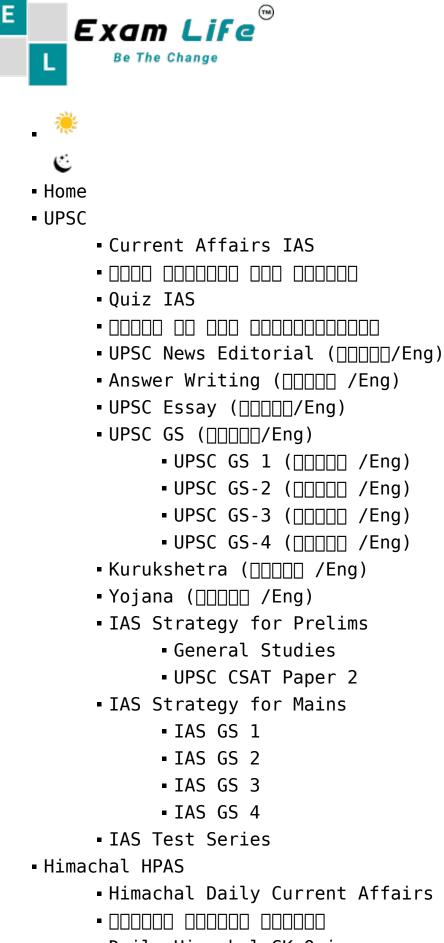

- All member countries appreciated India's efforts for organizing the first meeting of the Governing Board of BIMSTEC Energy Centre and expressed that such meetings of BIMSTEC may happen more frequently


