- Statehood Day commemorates the formation day of

Himachal Pradesh as a state. However, Himachal Day 2023 should not be confused with Statehood Day.

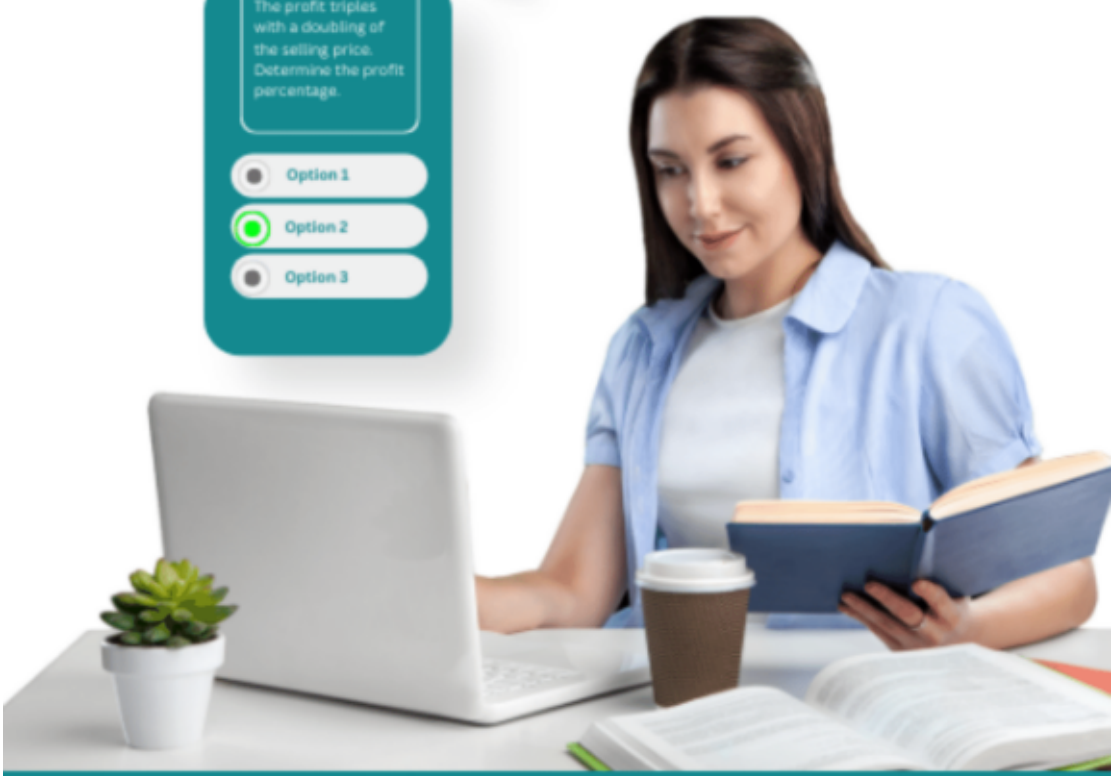
